“HOW TO” RECYCLING SHEET RESIDENTIAL RECYCLING ONLY

Materials to be Commingled	What Do I Recycle?	Cleaning and Preparation	What Can't Be Recycled?
Glass	Bottles and Jars ONLY Green, Clear, & Brown	Remove Lids and Discard in Trash RINSE CLEAN REMOVE RINGS	Windows, Mirrors, Light bulbs and Tubes, Pyres and Dishes, Drinking Glasses, Chemical Bottles, Medical Containers, Laboratory Glass
Aluminum	Cans ONLY	RINSE CLEAN, Flattening Optional	Foil and Bottle Caps
Tin & Steel Cans	Food Cans ONLY	RINSE CLEAN Flattening Optional	Cardboard Sides Juice Cans, Aerosol Cans, Paint Cans
Plastic	Milk, Soda, and Detergent Bottles, Other Bottles marked #1 PETE or #2 HDPE	RINSE CLEAN Remove and Discard Lids in Trash	Styrofoam, Plastic Cups and Film, Hard Plastic (Toys, Pails, etc.) Medicine Bottles & Syringes

OTHER RECYCLABLE MATERIALS

Materials To Be Commingled	What Do I Recycle?	What Can't Be Recycled?
Newspapers, Magazines, Office Paper and Cardboard ONLY	Newspapers, Magazines, Cardboard Card Stock, Office Paper, Books, Envelopes, Paper Other Examples: Brown Paper Tape, Computer Printouts, File Folders-Manila, Glued Pads, Tablets, Phone Books, Post-It Notes, and ANY Junk Mail	Bathroom Waste Paper(towels, toilet paper), Wrapping paper, Carbon Paper, Cellophane, Cloth, Cork, Foil, Polystyrene Styrofoam, anything Waxed, Candy Wrappers, Napkins, Paper Cups, Styrofoam Cups, Styrofoam or Paper Food Containers, Photographs, Fiberboard, Labels and Label Backings

Recycling Rules

- ✓ Glass, aluminum, tin and steel cans, and plastics shall be mixed together in one clear/blue bag or 18 gallon recycling bin
- ✓ Newspapers, magazines, cardboard, and office paper shall be bundled together in paper bag or bundled with string
- ✓ Cardboard must be no longer than 24" x 24"
- ✓ All other materials shall be placed in the Trash container
