

## SERVING JESUS IN OUR COMMUNITY... **REACHING OUT!**

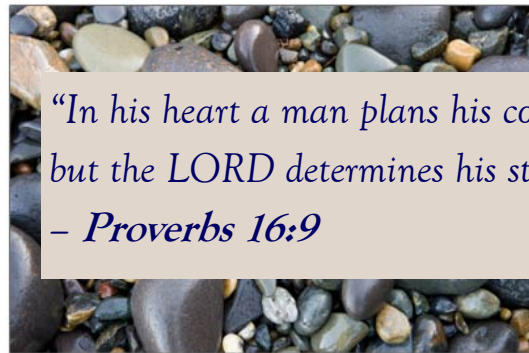
### SOME OF OUR RECENT PROJECTS INCLUDE:

## HUDDLE: BUILDING & RELEASING LEADERS

We currently have two Huddle groups, that meet twice a month. These groups were both "born" from our original Huddle group, and serve as a place for in-depth study and personal growth, and leadership. One group has started the Life Shapes study, and the other group has been studying Frank Viola's "Reimagining Church".
