### WCCA Meeting Minutes April 18, 2018

President Al Shook called the meeting to order at 7:30 pm at the Ojibwa Bowhunters' clubhouse. The meeting was sponsored by the Ojibwa Bowhunters, who provided the refreshments. The meeting was attended by 17 individuals, comprised of club delegates and the Wisconsin Conservation Congress.

#### **SECRETARY'S REPORT:**

The minutes of the March meeting were accepted as published.

#### **TREASURER'S REPORT:**

The following funds were received: raffle sales proceeds, memberships. The following funds were disbursed: December raffle winnings, scholarship, Wales Genesee Game Feed donation.

The Treasurer's report was approved.

  - The DNR has published the hearing results as well as all resolutions on the DNR's website.

#### **COMMITTEE REPORTS:**

- **Conservation Congress** –
  - Al Shook –
    - Elections were held at the spring hearings: MarySusan Diedrich and Robert Wisek were elected to the Congress. Waukesha County had the 3<sup>rd</sup> largest attendance.
  - Tom Daluga –
    - CDAC – Finalized to maintain the herd size with 750 bonus public tags and 1,850 bonus private tags. A holiday hunt will take place. The bow season will extend through the end of January, either sex can be harvested. There was a glitch in the tag purchasing this year. To note, only 3% of tag holders harvest more than one deer.
    - Licensing is changing – all applicable licenses will receive an automatic fall turkey tag, the zone will still be required.
- **Wisconsin Wildlife Federation** – Wisconsin Wildlife Federation – Annual meeting is 4/20-21, most information is in the Wisconservation.
- **Kids Fishing Clinic** – Ron Gray spoke to the following items: 14 parks participated, and every park had a clinic. The WCFSO and clubs hosting the clinics thank the WCCA for the rods, which came up to two rods per park. There were complaints of overharvesting. Due to the weather (which was bad), one club wanted to cancel, but the date/time is publicized. Also, the size of the planted fish has increased.

## OLD BUSINESS:

- **Activities** –

- **Donation Requests** – Additional donation requests were made, motions for and accepted were as follows:
  - **Walk Run Roll American Legion** – A motion was made and carried to donate \$100 which enables the WCCA to have its logo on the shirts. This accommodated previously veteran based allocated funds.
  - **Schultz Take Aim at Cancer Event** – A request to donate \$300 to cover food and beverages was made. A motion was made to forward directly to the members of the WCCA. The motion passed. Information from the WCCA is displayed on the handouts.
- **Oconomowoc Mills Fleet Farm** – A new Mills Fleet Farm is in the Pabst Farm area. KKR bought out Mills Fleet Farm to get more involved with the communities, and they reached out to the WCCA as a conservation group to want to know what's going on in Waukesha County. Jody is the contact. Representatives of the WCCA will be meeting Wednesday or Thursday to speak to representatives from Minnesota.
- **Awards** – The WCCA has been given a state award by the Wisconsin Conservation Congress. On May 11<sup>th</sup>, Tom Daluga will accept it on behalf of the Alliance.
