**WCCA Meeting Minutes November 14, 2018**

A board meeting was held prior to the meeting. The following donation items were brought forth for discussion:

- Youth Conservation Delegate (Rosa) – Requested funds towards attending a school. Motion was made and approved for a \$500 grant to be brought to the members for a vote.
- Monches – Requested funds towards property maintenance at the club relating to gravel for access/logging/planning/invasive species removal, etc. Motion was made and approved for a \$300 donation to be brought to the members for a vote.
- Veterans Funds – Request was made for funds towards Christmas with the Vets at the Zablocki Center. Motion was made and approved for a \$250 cash donation to be brought to the members for a vote.

President Al Shook called the meeting to order at 7:35 pm at the Dousman Gun Club. The meeting was sponsored by the Dousman Gun Club, who provided the refreshments. The meeting was attended by 19 individuals, comprised of club delegates and the Wisconsin Conservation Congress.
