WCCA Meeting Minutes **February 18, 2026**

Wincek, President called the meeting to order at 7:30 pm. The meeting was sponsored by Great Lakes Sportsmen Fishing Club held at Wales/Genesee Lions Club.

The meeting was attended by 13 individuals, comprised of Club Delegates and Wisconsin Conservation Congress Delegates. Quorum was declared.

Secretary's Report

Membership was asked if there were any corrections or additions to the January 21, 2026 General Meeting Minutes. Motion by Zettelmeier, second by Luling to accept the Minutes as published. Motion carried. Minutes are always posted to the WCCA Website.

Treasurer's Report

- Report presented by Farchmin to Membership in attendance. A motion was made by Schmidt, second by Jorgenson to accept the Treasurer's report, subject to audit. Motion carried.
- Gave a preliminary Report on the Banquet. WCCA netted approximately \$10,410. Increased the revenue on all but 3 of the firearms. Biggest ticket takers were: Ruger RXM 9MM, S & W 9mm, Turkey .410 with scope and the Springfield.

Committee Reports

DNR (news updates from dnr.wi.gov)

- The WCC/DNR Spring Hearings will be Monday, April 13, 2026, 7:00pm. Jeff Hintz and Bob Wincek, WCCA Board Members, are both up for re-election this year. Please mark your calendars, as we need your voices heard at this important meeting. Possible meeting place will be the new building at Lapham Peak. State should not have to charge for the facility and they are working on free parking.
 - Resolutions submissions closed. About 400 were submitted. Now being reviewed.
 - One Resolution entitled: Reauthorization of Knowles-Nelson Stewardship Program had over 150 submissions. Citizens want it to go back to purchasing some land, but to improve recreational infrastructure boat ramp facilities, recreational trails and to provide land purchases for parks and

nature preserves statewide. The program supports land conservation, public access and habitat protection.

- CDAC meeting will be held on April 20, 2026, 600pm at DNR Service Center in Waukesha. Would like input from hunters on private property hunting areas.

Kids Fishing Clinic

- Dates for 2026 Clinics: Wern Valley will be April 25, 2026, 900am to 100pm. DBCL will be June 27, 2026, 900am to Noon. Grants will be requested for payout.
- Ice Fishing was on January 31, 2026, 900am to 200pm 43 attendees. Regular fishing is on April 18, 2026, 900am-200pm at Greenfield Park.
- Shook received \$500 at the banquet from Wales/Genesee Lions Club to offset costs of fish stocking at Wern Valley.
- Diedrich requested \$500 to offset fish stocking at DBCL light lunch for kids as well as purchase prizes for the kids. Hopefully, Monches Fish & Game will come through with some of those prizes. Motion by Jorgenson, second by Schmidt to give the \$500 to Diedrich. Motion passed.
