Register sale cattle at the Entry Office before 5:00 p.m. Saturday, September 29. A receipt of sale and the original registration paper will authenticate the breed and ownership of World Beef Expo sale animals.

All exhibitors are expected to familiarize themselves with the General Rules & Regulations.

Rules Specific to the Junior Heifer Show

- Age of Exhibitors.** Exhibitors must be between **the ages of 8 and 21 as of January 1, 2018**, to participate in the Junior Heifer Show. Anyone found ineligible will be disqualified from the show.
- Ownership.** All heifers entered in the Junior Heifer Show must be owned by the participating junior exhibitor on or before check-in time of the Junior Show, with the exception of any animal purchased at a World Beef Expo sale. Junior exhibitors must be present to show their animal(s).
- Breed Divisions**

Purebred All purebred cattle must have five (5) or more head checked in to establish a breed division. If less than five (5) head are checked in, the cattle will compete in the Any Other Breed-Purebred division. (329)

Percentage All percentage cattle must have five (5) or more head checked in to establish a percentage breed division. If less than five (5) head are checked in, the cattle will compete in the Any Other Breed Percentage Division. (330)
- Classes.** Breed heifers (purebred and low percentage) will be shown youngest to oldest. Commercial heifers will be shown by weight, lightest to heaviest. *Show management reserves the right to break and combine classes as needed.*

Junior Show

All purebred breeds with less than five head will show in Any Other Breed –Purebred and all percentage breeds with less than five head will show in Any Other Breed -Percentage.

*All Junior Angus exhibitors must read the Junior Angus Participation Statement.

World Beef Expo will determine show order based on entry numbers. Show order is subject to change up to and during the show. If one ring is moving faster, some breeds may be moved to the other ring so that both rings finish about the same time. Listen for announcements on day of show.

Registered Breed Females

Class

- 1 Cow/Calf Pair – Three (3) years of age and younger. Cow calved January 1, 2015 - August 31, 2016.
Calf must be the cow's most recent natural calf and may not exceed 280 days of age on day of show.
 - 2 Cow/Calf Pair – Four (4) years of age and older. Cow calved December 31, 2014 and earlier.
Calf must be the cow's most recent natural calf and may not exceed 280 days of age on day of show.
