ENTRY FEES AND DEADLINES

Rules Specific to the Chianina Show

1. All cattle must be registered in the American Chianina Association (ACA) Herdbook and be at least 50% or greater Chianina percentage. Original registration certificates must be presented to the superintendent at the show. All tattoos will be checked and must match the registration certificate. Any animal without a tattoo or with a tattoo that does not correspond with its registration certificate will be ineligible to compete.
2. The surgical or non-surgical alteration of conformation of an animal is prohibited. This includes: altering the conformation by tying up the dewlap or creating tucks by using adhesive on the dewlap, brisket, sheath, or navel. Cattle are to be shown in their natural conformation.
 - a. No altering of the heads or removal or scurs from Chiangus cattle is permitted. If a Chianina head has been altered in any way, that animal is not eligible to be shown as a Chiangus.
 - b. All horned Chianina, Chimaine and Chiford animals must be dehorned prior to being shown.
 - c. The use of false tail heads is strictly prohibited.
 - d. The addition of hair or any similar substance to any part of an animal's body is prohibited.
 - e. Dyeing or artificially changing the color of an animal is prohibited. Coloring agents may be used on the legs and tail switches. No powder of any kind may be used on any part of an animal.
3. **All bulls must have a permanent nose ring with a lead attached to the ring.**
4. All cattle will be made available for a veterinary examination to determine the presence of altering. All cattle will be made available for a veterinary examination to be mouthed. An exhibitor must agree to abide by the determination(s) of the examining veterinarian(s).

No premiums will be offered for this show.

GROUP CLASSES

Group classes will be entered at the show.

Get-of-Sire: Four animals by one sire, both sexes represented

Junior Get-of-Sire: Three animals by one sire, both sexes represented

Breeder's Best Six Head: Six head, both sexes represented, bred and owned by a single exhibitor

NOTE: All animals exhibited in a single group class entry must be owned by the exhibitor, who will have a single member code. Exceptions will be made for cattle who are bred and owned by an immediate family member (spouse, legal child, brother/sister, parent).
