### ENTRY FEES AND DEADLINES

Early Entry Deadline	August 15, 2019	\$60 per head
Entry Deadline	September 1, 2019	\$80 per head
Late Entry	After September 1, 2019	\$100 per head

Entry fees include bedding and tie-out space. Bedding will be available upon arrival at World Beef Expo. Exhibitors are responsible for their own bedding for tie-outs.

### Rules Specific to the South Devon Cattle Shows

- Each individual breed will have its own individual show.** All Open Show breeds, regardless of the number of entries, will show individually and recognize their own champions.
- Fewer than ten entries:** Any breed show with fewer than ten paid entries will have its champion(s) eligible for Any Other Breed (AOB) champion. The AOB champion in each division – heifer, bull, cow/calf pair – will then qualify for the Supreme Champion Drive.  
**Ten or more entries:** Any breed show with ten or more paid entries will have its champion(s) automatically eligible for the Supreme Champion Drive.  
*See Rule 12 in the World Beef Expo General Rules & Regulations for more details.*
- Each animal being shown must be registered with the appropriate breed organization, and the original registration certificate must be made available for inspection. Each animal must have a legible tattoo that corresponds with its registration certificate.
- Animals must be fitted in an ethical manner. Unethical fitting is grounds for disqualification. Unethical fitting includes, but is not limited to, the following:
  - Altering the natural color of the animal through the use of dyes, paints, hair-coloring conditioners, colored show foam, graphite, colored powders, or any other substances.
  - The addition of any hair or hair-like substance, including false tail heads and false polls. False tail switches are allowed.
  - The cutting, tearing, or gluing of the hide or beneath the hide, or removal of tissue, in an attempt to alter the shape of the animal.
  - The injection of any gas, solid, or liquid under the hide to alter the natural conformation.
  - Any attempts to disrupt or change the normal dental development of the animal.
  - Any products/solutions/liquids administered internally or externally to alter the conformation of the animal. This includes the use of steroids, growth stimulants, and the act of artificially filling animals internally – which includes stomach pumping, drench tubes, or any other method per os (by esophagus).  
**EXCEPTIONS:** In the case of severely sick or dehydrated animals, the exhibitor may have fluids and/or electrolytes administered by the licensed official World Beef Expo veterinarian with the approval of the show management.
