Motion by Shook, second by Daluga to give them \$1000.00, which is their total cost for the event. Discussion: Farchmin – they only want \$250 as they have other sponsors. Schmitt suggested making it \$500 instead. Voice vote rejected Motion. Grant money of \$250 will be given to Adaptive Sportsmen Inc. as per requested.
