Early History of Child Advocates in Fort Bend County

Fort Bend Child Advocates was created in 1991 by **Suzy Kern**. She attended volunteer training in Houston, then asked how to link up with the Fort Bend program. She was told that none existed. Suzy contacted the State organization and learned how to start the program here.

The first office space was donated as was the original furniture and machines. She asked her lawyer husband to prepare and file for Incorporation, and he also prepared the Bylaws and other corporate documents. Together, they applied for and obtained a charitable designation from the IRS. She served as the original Director and did not draw a salary, believing that the organization needed to devote its meager assets to its real goal, the children, although some time later she was reimbursed for expenses. She resigned in late 1992. The speaker is proud of CASA and proud of Suzy.
