I intend never to forget the battered, bruised bodies of my grandchildren. Blue serves as a constant reminder to me to fight for protection for our children.

This story demonstrates the effect that we can have in Fort Bend County. Since that first ribbon there have been millions across the country tying blue ribbons to make more people aware of child abuse. There will be many Exchange Clubs across the Nation working to tell the public that we must help **Prevent Child Abuse**. In Sugar Land we will be doing the same thing.
