Highway 59 is now Interstate 69. There are plans to expand 99 to 290 with overpasses. Also, Crabb River Road will be expanded to 4 lanes from 59 South past George High School. Levees will continue to be built to insure protection from flooding.

The YMCA of Greater Houston and Fort Bend County entered into a partnership for the development of a regional outdoor education day camp facility at the current Bates Allen Park in Kendleton, Texas. The Fort Bend County Park of 235 acres includes three lakes, beautiful San Bernard River access, nature trails, picnic pavilions, restrooms and a river fishing pier. In addition, the Park is home to the Fort Bend County Heritage Unlimited History Museum.
