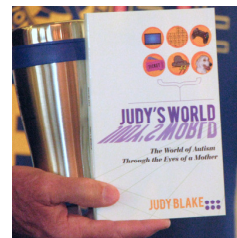
### Different does not mean less than!

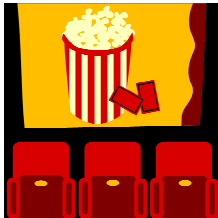
