We spend two hours per night organizing and setting up the church for the event. We need your help, please consider volunteering at least one night.

On Saturday December 20th we have three shifts available because we don't want anyone to miss the opportunity to get involved. First shift is from 7am to noon. Second shift is from noon to 4pm. Third shift is from 4pm to 7pm. If you are feeling very Christmassy you can combine shifts so you don't miss any of the action.

This ministry began thirty years ago when Carolyn Tarver's young son died in an accident. Carolyn wanted to honor his memory by helping less fortunate children at Christmastime. ECSL is proud to carry on this legacy and we recently enlisted the help of Toys for Tots. Toys for Tots recognizes the role ECSL plays in providing a Christmas for those in need in Fort Bend County. Our goal of serving 5000 children is going to make this year's Santa's Exchange the biggest ever.
