The Big "E" is one of the highest honors bestowed on a club because it represents Excellence (Doug Earle says it is Enthusiasm!) in the area of club growth, service projects, and meeting reporting requirements. **John Robson** deservedly was recognized for his efforts by receiving the Distinguished President's Award. Amendments to the National Exchange Bylaws that were proposed were voted on, the results were as follows:

Amendment 1: increasing the Lifetime member cost to \$1,000 was approved.

Amendment 2: increasing time a person can be eligible for Lifetime Membership 30 years for member of continuous membership and 20 years for person 65 years of age. It was amended to reduce the years to 10 years membership for 65 and older. Approved.

Amendment 3: changed billing date for Excel Clubs to October. Approved.

Amendment 4: withdrawn

Amendment 5: Excel club membership - non-voting affiliate status. Did not pass.

Amendment 6: withdrawn. Amendment 7: withdrawn.

We are excited about the new year and have set our goals high to achieve the Big E and continue to increase our club membership. I truly believe we can achieve these goals in the coming year and I look forward to working with each of you to fulfill our unmet needs and to have FUN doing it!
