Dear Exchangites and Prospective Exchangites,

As the 2015 year comes to a close I thought it would be nice to reflect upon the impact we have made this past year. Through your tireless efforts The Exchange Club of Sugar Land has impacted the lives of many children and families in Fort Bend County.

This past year we were able to provide approximately 750 children and teens with school supplies and new shoes in August of 2015 as a part of the Walk with Pride Program we coordinate with Fort Bend Social Services. December 12, 2015 we were able to provide a very special holiday for approximately 4,500 children through Santa's Exchange. Each child was able to receive 3 gifts that they were able to open on Christmas Day.

We distributed over 15,000 American Flags to children through our participation in the Fort Bend County Fair Parade, Houston Rodeo Parade, and at the Memorial Day Celebration at the Memorial Park in Sugar Land. We also presented two Freedom Shrines to schools in Fort Bend County which are made up of documents that represent the founding of our nation and the rights we have as American citizens.

We are also able to continue to support the E.S.C.A.P.E. Center, Child Advocates of Fort Bend and The Fort Bend Women's Center as a part of our National Exchange Project, which is the Prevention Child Abuse. These funds are used to provide parenting classes, counseling services and supports to children and families. We are able to assist children with Autism Spectrum Disorders through our support of Hope for Three and the Texana Center Children's Autism Program.

Last year we recognized 16 High School Students and 12 Middle School Students who exhibited excellence in Academic Achievement and Community Service. We believe that by honoring these students, we are instilling the value of community service and the impact it can have. We also have honored students that have overcome hardships to achieve excellence through our A.C.E. (Accepting the Challenge of Excellence) award. Thank you for making 2015 a great year and I look forward to seeing what we accomplish in 2016!
