Hurricane Harvey visited Sugar Land, Texas during the week of August 25th and dropped over three feet of rain on the local area. The highest daily rainfall was reported to be 16.07 inches of rain. Some areas had over 50 inches of rain over several days.

779,000 faced mandatory evacuation. 980,000 faced voluntary evacuation. 21,000+ federal workers and 14,000+ National Guardsmen assisted in rescue and clean-up.







19 tornados touched down and destroyed property in and around Ft. Bend County.


30% of Harris
