Exciting, Crazy Moments at 7am Breakfast Meeting with our “White Elephant Gift Exchange”

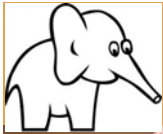

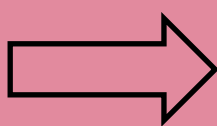
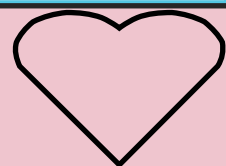
