Message from the President



SEPTEMBER 11 TOUCHED EVERYONE

My daughter Leslie lived three miles from the Pentagon that day and says:

"When I woke up, I went to my computer (always) to check e-mail and to talk to friends in Houston. My friend, Jim, instant messaged me frantically. "Leslie, a plane has just hit one of the

towers at the World Trade Center. TURN ON THE NEWS. As I went to the television, I heard a sonic boom that sounded like it was just across the street. The walls rattled. My neighbor told me that the noise was so loud that one of the pictures had come off her wall. Because of the distance of the Pentagon from my house, I didn't suspect what had happened until I saw a feed of it on CNN. It was then that I went into complete and total shock."

Soon I was to learn that Barbara Olson was on that Pentagon plane. Though she was an important commentator and lawyer and author she was also the kid sister to one of my friends and the daughter of someone I loved very much. Soon I would speak at her Houston Memorial service. Days of shock and worry followed but it was wonderful how people pulled together.

Remember. And be thankful for the "Divine privilege of single and collective responsibility as life's noblest gift" to make our world, our commune and our lives better and stronger BECAUSE WE REMEMBER.






9/16/2018 was Judge Kern's 50th anniversary as a lawyer and his 19th as a District Judge.
