As your incoming President, I commit to the following:

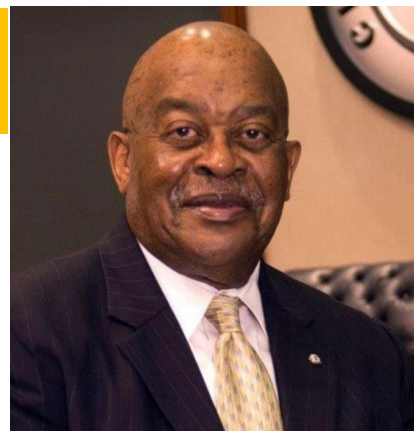
- To listen. In order to properly provide you with what you **need**, I have to listen to what you **want**.

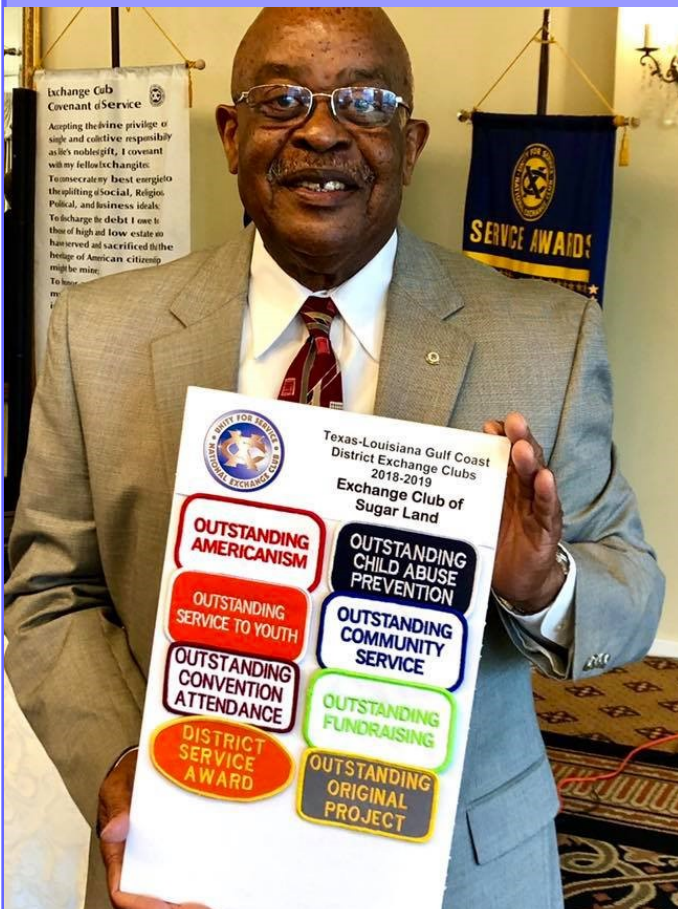
