One of our most important programs of this service is The Prevention of Child Abuse, and Childproof America works within our communities to do just that. Founded in 2019...the goal is to make our communities safer places to live.

This first-in-nation program matches parents in crisis with a trained and vetted Family Guide who will serve as the point of contact when their child is missing and deemed a victim of trafficking. The Family Guide will help parents navigate the traumatic and fast paced process with law enforcement, social media, schools, local and statewide resources.
