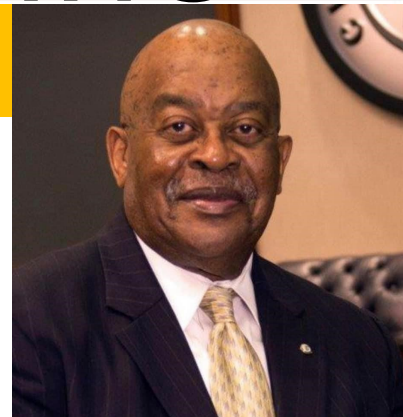
From The President

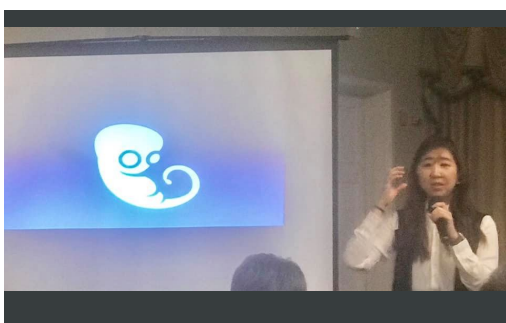
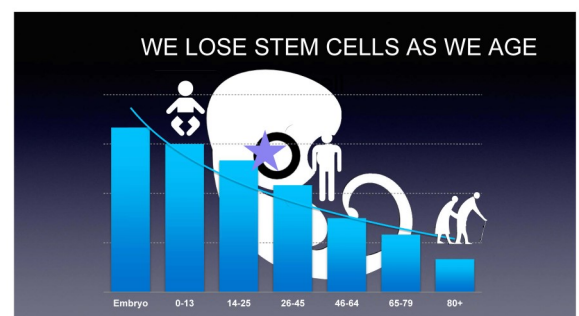
Since 2007, Donna Chang has served as an executive in commercial stem cell companies and headed up regulatory and marketing Activities, and facilitated research and partnering agreements.
