- 2. Consider and Act on the Conditional Use Request (CU48) Jeffrey S. Ogrezovich for land altering activities associated with the construction of a single-family residence. The subject property is described as Lot 1, CSM No. 11724, located in part of the NE ¼ of Section 1, T7N, R17E, Town of Oconomowoc. More specifically, the property is located at N48 W34111 Jaeckles Drive, Nashotah, WI 53058. (Tax Key No. OCOT 0577.001.001). Commissioner Navin made the motion to approve the conditional use request (CU48) of Jeffrey S Ogrezovich for land altering activities associated with the construction of a single-family residence per Administrator/Planner Herrmann recommendations/memo dated October 29, 2020. Commissioner Navin made the motion to approve the Site Plan/Plan of Operation for Michael Schurstadt, d/b/a Baker Meister, N51W34922 Wisconsin Avenue to remodel the ground floor apartment behind the Baker Meister store to provide additional storage space per the recommendation of Administrator/Planner Herrmann's report dated October 29, 2020.
