# TOWN OF OCONOMOWOC BOARD OF SUPERVISORS REGULAR BOARD MEETING MINUTES

# **CLOSED SESSION:**

The Board will enter, by roll call vote, into Closed Session pursuant to State Statute 19.85 (1) (e) deliberating or negotiating the purchasing of public properties, the investing of public funds, or conducting other specified business, whenever competitive or bargaining reasons require a closed session (City of Oconomowoc).

<u>Approve Minutes from the Regular Town Board Meeting on February 4, 2019</u>. – Supervisor Rutkowski made the motion to approve the Regular Town Board meeting minutes for February 4, 2019 as presented. Supervisor Largent seconded the motion. Motion carried by unanimous voice vote.

### Comments from the Floor on Agenda items or any other items.

Jim Roche, a member of the Plan Commission, stated/commented regarding the Highway Department doing an exceptional job clearing the roads the last few snow storms.

Brad Bowen, Fire Chief of Western Lakes, gave an overview of the department for the last month.

### **NEW BUSINESS:**

- <u>Consider and Act on Equipment purchase for Stone Bank Fire Department</u>. After considerable discussion, the Board decided to table this line item until the next meeting so they could have a representative from the Stone Bank Fire Department here to respond to questions the Board has regarding the equipment.
