# TOWN OF OCONOMOWOC BOARD OF SUPERVISORS REGULAR BOARD MEETING MINUTES

Monday, July 18, 2022 at 6:00 p.m.

Chairman Robert C. Hultquist called the meeting to order at 6:00 p.m. Supervisor's present included John Koepke, John Roelandts, Erik Mullett and Terry Largent. Also in attendance were Police Chief Kristen Wraalstad and Administrator/Planner Jeffrey Herrmann. Highway Superintendent Sam Salzman and Clerk/Treasurer Lori Opitz were excused. Those present stood to recite The Pledge of Allegiance.

<u>Approve Minutes from Regular & Special Town Board meeting June 20, 2022</u>. – Supervisor Roelandts made the motion to approve the regular & special Town Board meeting minutes from June 20, 2022 as presented. Supervisor Koepke seconded the motion. Motion carried by unanimous voice vote.

#### Comments from the Floor on Agenda items or any other items.

Dawn Anderson, W352N6080 Bauer's Lane stated the area did a traffic study and the area doesn't have "two" lanes to the road that it actually 1 ½ lanes and the area does qualify to reduce the speed limit to 15 on the road because it is a narrow residential road and all 16 residents in the area would like it reduced to 15 mph.

## **OLD BUSINESS:**

- Discussion on Ordinance 2022-2; An Ordinance to repeal and recreate Section 175-16.1 and creating section 175-16.2 of the Town of Oconomowoc Municipal Code to restrict the use of motorcycles upon frozen lakes. After considerable discussion regarding this ordinance to the Ashippun Lake area, the Board asked Administrator/Planner Herrmann to meet with the Ashippun Lake representatives and complete a survey of the residents in the area on there thoughts regarding this ordinance and have Administrator/Planner Herrmann bring back a report regarding whether or not the Town will pass this ordinance.
- 2. Consider and Act on Ordinance 2022-4; An Ordinance to create Chapter 5, Article III of the General Code of ordnances of the Town of Oconomowoc relating to the establishment of an architectural committee. Supervisor Roelandts made the motion to approve Ordinance 2022-4; An Ordinance to create Chapter 5, Article III of the General Code of ordinance of the Town of Oconomowoc relating to the establishment of an architectural committee. Supervisor Mullett seconded the motion. Motion carried by unanimous voice vote.
- 3. Consider and Act on Bauer's Lane Speed Study. Chief Wraalstad stated they did a study on the road the week of June 21<sup>st</sup> through June 27<sup>th</sup>. She stated during that week there were 437 vehicles that went through; one car did 34 MPH, one car at 26 MPH, four cars at 22 MPH and one care at 21 MPH; the rest were under 20 MPH. Administrator/Planner Herrmann stated the state would allow the road to be set at 15 MPH. Chairman Hultquist made the motion to approve Administrator/Planner Herrmann to work with the Town Attorney to get the speed limit on Bauer's Lane down to 15 MPH. Supervisor Koepke seconded the motion. Motion carried by unanimous voice vote.

#### **NEW BUSINESS:**

- Discussion on potential borrowing for Road Construction Projects. Cameron, a representative from Ehler's presented to the Board the difference scenarios of what it would cost to borrow \$3.5 million for the Town Roads and looking at about 3.7% interest rate and the bond payment amounts at 5 years, 7 years and 10 years. The Board agreed the best option for the Town would be for the borrowing would be the 7-year term and asked Administrator/Planner Herrmann work with Ehler's on the process.
