1. Approve minutes for May 17, 2010 Public Hearing and Plan Commission meeting

Agenda 5 of Plan Commission minutes – Last sentence of next to last paragraph shall read “Jeff stated that the Town cannot regulate hours for liquor licensed premises.”

3. Consider and act on Site Plan/Plan of Operation for Ingersoll Farm Markets – W359 N5828 Brown Street

Peregrine moved to recommend that the Town approve the Site Plan/Plan of Operation for Ingersoll Farm Markets subject to Jeff's memo dated June 2, 2010. Seconded by Garvey. Carried unanimously. Jeff stated that the County may require that the stand and the wagon be 50 ft from the right-of-way; however there is not room for this and as this would be a temporary use and would not interfere with traffic it was not seen as a problem.
