10.16.010 Snowmobile defined.

"Snowmobile" is defined as any enginedriven vehicle using sled runners or skis to steer and a belt-like tread for propulsion. (Ord. 2004-9)

10.16.020 State snowmobile and allterrain vehicle laws adopted.

All Wisconsin state laws pertaining to the regulation of snowmobiles (Wis Stats 350.01 et seq) are adopted and made a part of this chapter by reference. (Ord. 2010-5)

10.16.030 Operation on village streets, alleys, and sidewalks.

A. No person shall operate a snowmobile on any village street, alley, or sidewalk except to drive directly across a street or sidewalk, and then only after stopping and yielding the right-of-way to all vehicles and persons on said street, alley, or sidewalk. (Ord. 2007-9)

B. No snowmobile shall be left parked unattended on any street, alley, or sidewalk at any time. (Ord. 2007-9)

10.16.040 Operation on private property.

No person shall operate a snowmobile on any private property, other than property owned by the operator, without the consent of the property owner. (2007-9)

10.16.050 Snowmobile operation and speed limit.

A. Snowmobiles shall only be operated in areas designated as "official marked trails."

B. Snowmobiles shall not travel at a speed greater that 15 miles per hour on any "official marked trail" that is within the village limits. (2010-5)

10.16.060 Penalty for violation.

Any person who shall violate any of the provisions of this chapter shall, upon conviction thereof, be subject to a penalty as provided in Chapter 1.20 of this code. (2007-9)
