

**Chapter 5.12  
Cigarettes**

the provisions of this section and the court in its judgment shall determine that he was personally guilty of a failure to exercise due care to prevent violation, his license privileges shall be terminate immediately and he shall not be entitled to another license nor act as an agent or servant of another licensee for five years thereafter. **5.12.010 License required.**

No person shall in any manner, directly or indirectly, manufacture, sell, exchange, dispose of or give away or keep for sale any cigarettes or cigarette papers or wrappers without first obtaining a license from the village clerk in the manner provided in Section 134.65 Wisconsin Statutes. This section shall not apply to jobbers or manufacturers doing interstate business with customers outside Wisconsin. (Prior code § 11.05(1))

**5.12.020 Fee.**

The fee for such cigarette license shall be set from time-to-time by resolution of the village board and must be presented to the village clerk before any license is hereunder issued. (Prior code § 11.05(2)) (Ord. 2007-2)

**5.12.030 Form of license — Expiration —  
Transfer.**

All cigarette licenses shall be signed by the village clerk and indicate thereon the name of the licensee and the place where he is authorized to conduct the licensed business and shall expire on June 30<sup>th</sup> next succeeding the date of issue. (Amended during 1996 codification; prior code § 11.05(3))

**5.12.040 Violation — Penalty.**

The penalty for violation of any provision of this section shall be as provided in Chapter 1.20 of this code. A separate offense shall be deemed committed on each day upon which a violation occurs or continues. If any person shall be convicted of a second or subsequent violation of
