##### **DNR (news updates from [dnr.wi.gov](http://dnr.wi.gov))**

- CDAC meeting was held on April 20, 2026, 6:00pm at DNR Service Center in Waukesha. After much discussion we left the number of permits the same as last year.
  - Scott Ford resigned. All positions will be renewed by end of June 2026. Changes every 3 years.
  - Some discussion that the meetings may go back to two meetings a year, as in the past. First meeting obtains info from Biologist and reads through citizen's input. Second meeting final decisions, based on info obtained from first meeting.
  - Due to Waukesha County having much more farmland than Milwaukee, we are keeping the Counties separate for CDAC meeting.
  - Discussion on meaning of a Deer Metro Unit. It is an urbanized area in Deer Management unit.

## **Wisconsin Conservation Congress**

### **Wincek**

- Convention was held in Green Bay this year. May 14-16.
- Bob did not get a position on the District Leadership Council.
- Sometime during 3<sup>rd</sup> or 4<sup>th</sup> week of February 2027, WCC hopes to get a group together to talk with local Legislators in Madison. This is to make the Legislators aware of what the WCC does and current issues.

### **Diedrich**

- Resolution 680126, Funding the Knowles-Nelson Stewardship Program was presented to the Floor of the Congress for their decision. It was unanimous to forward through the channels to get it approved for the 2026 Budget.

### **Hintz**

- Explained about the Capitol Meeting with Legislators on Jan. 9, 2026. Groups of 5 members from various conservation groups (i.e.: WWF, WCC, PF, DU, WWA and several more) talked with groups of Legislators then went on their own to talk to their local Legislators.
- June of 2026 Hintz will be leaving Waukesha County to move to Adams County. He will no longer be on Waukesha County's local WCC. There is a vacancy on Adams County that he hopes to fill. Jay Moore will take his spot on the Waukesha County Delegation.

### **Farchmin**

- Waukesha County does have a youth member on the YCC. Solis did sit with us for part of the WCC meeting. Solis was very interested in the adult's participation in our meeting.

### **Luling**

- Also had input about Waukesha County's Youth member. Hope to get her involved with WCCA.

### **Scholarship**
