Register sale cattle at the Entry Office before 7:00 p.m. Saturday, September 23. A receipt of sale and the original registration paper will authenticate the breed and ownership of World Beef Expo sale animals.

All exhibitors are expected to familiarize themselves with the General Rules & Regulations.

Rules Specific to the Junior Heifer Show

- 1. **Age of Exhibitors**. Exhibitors must be between the ages of 8 and 21 as of January 1, 2017, to participate in the Junior Heifer Show.
- 2. **Ownership**. All heifers entered in the Junior Heifer Show must be owned by the participating junior exhibitor on or before check-in time of the Junior Show, with the exception of any animal purchased at a World Beef Expo sale. Junior exhibitors must be present to show their animal(s).

3. Breed Divisions

Purebred All purebred cattle must have five (5) or more head checked in to establish a breed division. If less than five (5) head checked in cattle will compete in the Any Other Breed Purebred division. (329)

Percentage All percentage cattle must have five (5) or more head checked in to establish a percentage breed division. If less than five (5) head checked in cattle will compete in the Any Other Breed Percentage Division. (330)

4. **Classes**. Breed heifers (purebred and low percentage) will be shown youngest to oldest. Commercial heifers will be shown by weight, lightest to heaviest. Show management reserves the right to break and combine classes as needed.
